WELCOME TO BERLIN-MOABIT

We are thrilled to invite you to the 12th Edition of the "International Eastercup Berlin-Moabit," proudly hosted by BC Lions Moabit 21!

The International Eastercup is an exciting international basketball tournament, and over the years, we've welcomed teams from five different continents – Europe, Africa, Asia, South America and North America.

Taking place right in the heart of capital city, the tournament will span five action packed days in Berlin-Moabit, with games happening across more than 10 gyms, within close proximity to one another. With excellent public transport connections, getting around will be comfortable with our **BVG-Ticket**.

The wheelchair competition will be held for the 10th consecutive time!

The newest segment added to Eastercup-History is Volleyball. The tournament there ends on Saturday evening. One of the newest segment added 2019 to Eastercup is called "Eastercup Masters 45+" and will give women and men over the age of 45 years an opportunity to play. Here players are expected to arrive until 12 am on the 3rd, but are warmly welcome to join before this time. The games will start friday(same day) at 1pm and will end with the finals on Sunday. Join us for a celebration of volleyball, culture, and competition! The host of this event is **Gods of the Volley**.

TIME OVERVIEW

SCHEDULE

Thursday, 2nd of April 2026 is mainly the arrival day, but the **5 opening games** will start at 6:30pm. The opening games will be played at **Alt-Moabit 10 (main gym)**, entrance over underground garage Alt-Moabit/Invalidenstr., 10557 Berlin.

Friday, 3rd of April

The tournament starts at 8.00 am. Join us for sports, culture and competition.

Saturday, 4th of April

Games and **finals** starting from 4pm taking place in the main gym. Finals 5x5 are played by the Adult categories in : Wheelchair, Women, Men, Mixed, University

We also have the finals accompanied by our **Allstar-Saturday-Night-Event** with competitions in Skills-Challenge / 3-Point-Contest / Dunking-Contest and a lot of events, music and entertainment.

Sunday, 5th of April

More games and finals from 4pm for GU20, BU20, GU22, BU22. Masters 45+, FIBA Wheelchair 3x3, FIBA 3x3,

Monday, 6th of April

Starting from 8:30 am until approx. 5 pm on 2 or 3 different courts in this sequence:

Mini U10 Mix, Mini U11 Mix, Mini U12 Mix, GU13, BU13, FIBA GU14, FIBA

BU14, GU15, BU15, GU16, BU16, GU17, BU17, GU18, BU18

Please note: If a team leaves before their final game, their deposit will not be refunded. To reschedule of final games are only possible before the tournament schedule is published!



COMPETITIONS

AGE GROUPS

Men (High & Low) & women - no age limit

Mixed adults - no age limit, one female player has to be on the court at all times Wheelchair-Basketball, FIBA 3x3, FIBA 3x3 Wheelchair, University, Mixed Volleyball - mixing is allowed, no age limit, teams are paired up with opponents of approximate age. There will be an additional men and women category.

Masters 45+ men & women - Two younger players (at least 40 years old at the time of the tournament) are allowed after consultation with the office.

Girls in U12, U13, U14, U15, U16, U17, U18, U20, U22,

Boys in U12, U13, U14, U15, U16, U17, U18, U20, U22,

Mixed teams are allowed in age groups U10-U12!

Any exceptions have to be confirmed in a written way by the tournament organization. The organization allows the inspection of age limits with official papers at the tournament. The players are obliged to have their official ID's ready when they are in the gym. Unannounced checks are possible through the organization or through the court managers. A violation of the age limit leads to the exclusion of the whole team (not club) from the tournament.

U10 - 2016 or later

U12 - 2014 or later

U14 - 2012 or later

U16 - 2010 or later

U18 - 2008 or later

U20 - 2006 or later

U22 - 2004 or later



GAMES

The organization guarantees every team a minimum of 4-5 games over the course of the tournament. From 8 team registrations per age group there are Play-Off resp. Play-Down games. In the case of only 7 teams in an age group registration, a placement game will be played alongside the group stage. All games are played 4 x 8 minutes running time.

Every tournament winning team will receive **winner T-shirts**, medals and a Berlin landmark, the **Buddybear**, as a trophy. Teams that place second and third also receive **medals**. The winner of the Play-Downs receives a trophy and is requested to attend the trophy ceremony after the respective Play-Off final. The price money goes to the winner of the wheelchair-5-on-5-competition this year.





RULES, SCHEDULE AND VIOLATIONS

All rules will be announced in a separate document.

Every team will be informed about their duty in tournament-office/schedule via e-mail. The e-mails/information will be send out a couple of days prior to the tournament. Teams have to do scorer table and streaming duties only on friday and saturday, before or after their games.

Teams that do not show up on time to their games and have not provided the office with a reasonable excuse one hour before the game starts, have to pay a violation fee of 75€.

Not showing up to game is a violation fee of 100€.

Not showing up to scorer table or streaming is a violation fee of 75€.

All fines will be deducted from the deposit. A violation of the age limit leads to the exclusion of the whole team from the tournament.

A committee will be assembled in case of protests or disqualifications during the tournament, which consists of the game organizer, a referee official and an office representative. The decision of this committee is definitive. Protests have to be reported immediately or at least 1 hour after the game ended at the tournament office. The protesting team will have to pay a processing fee of 50€ up in-front. If the protest turns out to be justified, the committee decides who behaved unfair, that team has to pay a fine of 50€.

A disqualification during a game leads to a suspension of one game and can be, after consultation with the affected player and referee, upgraded to multiple games or an exclusion from the tournament. This decision also is definitive. The respective fines will be deducted from the deposit at the end of the tournament.



COSTS & DEADLINES

COST SPLIT

Our costs are generated by following fees:

- 1. Starting-Fee
- 2. Cupcard-Fee
- 3. Deposit (will be returned after the tournament)
- 4. Catering-Fee
- 5. Possible Upgrade: Catering-Fee
- 6. Public Transport Fee

We split these costs to be as transparent as possible for you. To guarantee you our best prices it is mandatory to book some minimal packages for each category. In all areas you can upgrade as we explain down below for each.

STARTING-FEES

The starting fee has to be paid for each team that is registered. All starter fee packages include cupshirts 14x, entry to the Allstar-Saturday-Night-Event and a surprise from a local basketball shop

- 200€: 14 x Cupshirt (size indication via online registration)
- 2. Teams that stay at own accommodation (only for teams not from Berlin or Brandenburg) **450€**: 14 x Cupshirt (size indication via online registration)
- 3. only for FIBA 3x3 teams:

80€: 4x Cupshirt (size indication via online registration)





CUPCARD / ACCOMMODATION / DEPOSIT

Every participant needs a Cupcard to identify themselves and to experience the international tournament flair. Our guests can choose between 4 different Cupcard variations.

The Cupcard represents your type of sleeping accommodation for 4 nights and minimal catering.

The variations are: Berlin, NBA, Highschool, College.

An additional **deposit of 250€** for each team is mandatory and will be paid back after the tournament in case of no damage or violations to the rules. In case of Cupcard Highschool the deposit is 500€.

Generally it's possible to order Cupcard NBA and College after Deadline, we can't guarantee our prices. You need to expect higher prices per person. To cancel individual persons after deadline it **cost a fine of 50€ per canceled person plus the entire costs of the Cupcard.** A cancellation of a full team after the 2nd of March 2026 results in no refund.

CUPCARD BERLIN

- Only possible for teams from Berlin and Brandenburg
- No accommodation
- 25€ per person, all you can eat
 - o 3x lunch (from friday to sunday, days are not exchangeable) **Deposit of 250€** for each team, which will
 - be paid back after the tournament in case of no damage or violations to the rules

CUPCARD NBA

- o Hotel, while stocks last Deadline 28th of February
- Only 4-6 bedrooms (single/double/triple-bedrooms available on extra fee)
- Check-in is possible at any time. The keys for the rooms are available from 14:30 pm on the arrival day. On the day of your departure the rooms have to be thoroughly cleaned and the keys need to be handed over until 10am
- No meals and no breakfast included
 - => GOLD 200 € per person (4x nights in Berlin)
- => 160 € per person (3x nights in Berlin)
 - => SILVER 180 € per person (4x nights in Berlin)
- => 150 € per person (3x nights in Berlin)



CUPCARD HIGHSCHOOL

- o **Gym accommodation** in classrooms or similar
- No showers guaranteed only at the tournament courts guaranteed
- Please bring your own air mattresses, sleeping pads, pillows etc.
- No meals and no breakfast included
 - => **70 € per person** (4x nights in Berlin)
 - => 60 € per person (3x nights in Berlin)
- o In this case a deposit of 500€ is mandatory

CUPCARD COLLEGE

- o Hostel, while stocks last- Deadline 1st of March
- Only 4-8 bedrooms (single/double/triple-bedrooms available on extra fee)
- Check-in is possible at any time. The keys for the rooms are available from 14:30 pm on the arrival day. On the day of your departure the rooms have to be thoroughly cleaned and the keys need to be handed over until 10 am. Some hostels take a 15 € deposit per person for the keys.
- No meals and no breakfast included
 - => GOLD 180 € per person (4x nights in Berlin)
 - => 140 € per person (3x nights in Berlin)
 - => SILVER 140 € per person (4x nights in Berlin)—>Be fast to book!
 - => 110 € per person (3x nights in Berlin)



CATERING

We probably offer "All You Can Eat" for our participants.

Every participating team needs to order at least the "6 Meals" package. This is necessary because otherwise we can't offer the shown prices. You will be able to choose between a meat option (helal, no pork) and a vegan/vegetarian option for everyone who doesn't like meat or dairy.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

In Berlin the public transportation is called "BVG". The ABC fare means that it can be used within Berlin and to reach destinations a little outside of Berlin (for example Airport Berlin Brandenburg (BER)). To be able to offer these reduced prices every participant needs to book a ticket. The tickets are available for our guests in two different time frames:

PUBLIC TRANSPORT TICKET 02. - 06.04.2026 /

- Valid from 02. 06.04.2026, range ABC, per person
- Equals 16 € per person

ADDITIONALLY IT IS POSSIBLE TO UPGRADE WITH THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:

PUBLIC TRANSPORT Ticket 01. - 07.04.2026 / OPTIONAL

• 20 € per person

If you want to book more public transport tickets (for example parents, siblings) for the reduced Eastercup price, you can buy them in the office at court 1 - only payment in cash.



PAYMENT

DEADLINES + PAYMENT

Registration deadline is 1st of March 2026. Generally it's possible to order all Cupcards after deadline, but we can't guarantee availability and especially our prices.

We charge 50 € extra for late registrations after deadline because of the effort of schedule making.

The **Payment deadline is 25th March 2026**. All teams that have not made any kind of payment will be taken out of the schedule. **Early- Bird-Discounts** can be applied until 30th of November 2025. Early- Bird- Teams need to have payed at least the half of their total price until the **1**st **of January 2026** or the discount is invalid. First installments have to be paid 14 days after the online registration on to the tournaments bank account.

The Payment should be made by one bank account for an entire team. We do not want many separate transactions.

Good to Know & General Information

- Alba Berlin plays a home game in the UBER Arena during the event days, you can buy discounted tickets for following date: 03./ 04./ 05.
 March (TBA which exact date) vs. EWE Baskets Oldenburg
 - If interested, the organization can organize you discounted 24 hour tickets to the "Tropical Island", a waterpark near Brandenburg.
- With every Cupcard comes free entry to every tournament game + the Allstar-Saturday-Night-Event. You'll get cheaper prices for playing Minigolf-Moabit (Bildungsmarkt) close to Court 1. Additionally you will get discounts in selected restaurants and bars in Berlin-Moabit within a Cupcard. Public Transport Tickets can be delivered to airport (BER) or central bus station (ZOB Berlin) if needed.
- In the gyms in Moabit, at the office or in the catering area will be no free WIFI available. Every team representative should carry a working smart phone with internet connection. Changes in the results or schedule will be most likely communicated through our schedule-system (Cupmanager) or e-mail messages. We don't publish places of locations (Highschool/College/NBA) before publishing the game-schedule. Furthermore we don't offer shuttle-service to main station anymore.
- Teams can receive a certificate or diploma at any time in the office. All advanced trainings and special coaching's have a separate registration section on the website and can be filled in there:

- At least 2 courts will be wheelchair friendly.
- Every club/participating team can provide a sponsor. This sponsor will be represented with a mentioning in the tournament magazine, a presentation on social media and a print on the Cupshirt, which every participant receives. The sponsor has to transfer a minimum of 400 € to the tournaments bank account named above. Sponsors will also be given an official tax receipt for the tax office. The team that provided the sponsor will receive a compensation of 150 € on the final bill.
- We will again have a basketball shop in 2026. Every year it is located at court 1 and offers discounts up to 60 %. The official cup shirt can be bought any time in sizes from XS to XXXL for a price of 15 €. Pre ordered shirts can be picked up here at any time. The general opening times are 12 am to 8 pm. Teams also can preorder stuff for the tournament (T-Shirts, Hoodies etc.) Even after the tournament participants are able to get cheaper prices online until the



15th of August 2026 at "BC Lions Merch-Shop". The discount code will be sent to you via e-mail or handed to you on the spot after the tournament ends. <u>Please keep an eye on our program for more details.</u>

- o All teams, maximum 10 teams, will be contacted about a possible opening game via e-mail on 2nd of April.
- The best player of every Play-Off final will receive a little gift from the local basketball shop. Since we started 2022 with our new streaming partner SolidSports, all games will be streamed live online for the parents and fans. It is also possible to watch them real live at home after the tournament. This service can be bought online for a small fee. Information about it, will be publish on our website/social media.
